## Getting Around

### Bike:

Public Bike Parking is available at all of the Attractions; there will not be a Bike Coalition valet service at Pier 45.

### Public Transportation:

See 511.org for help scheduling your trip or Nextbus.com to see when the next bus is arriving.

#### Bus Lines:

- 28 Goes between the Exploratorium get on/off at Francisco and Fort Mason Center (line ends across from Fort Mason on Marina).
- 30 Goes from Downtown to the S.F. Maritime Park (get on/off at Hyde) then to the Exploratorium (get on or off at Jefferson).
- 47 Goes from anywhere along Van Ness Ave. to the S.F. Maritime Park (get on/off at Hyde) and then Pier 45 (get on/off at Taylor).
- 10 Goes from Downtown, along the Embarcadero to Pier 45 (get on/off at Taylor) and the S.F. Maritime Park (get on/off at Hyde).
- 20 Goes from Downtown to the S.F. Maritime Park (get on/off at Hyde)
- F Goes from Market St. and along the Embarcadero to Pier 45 (get on/off at Taylor).

### Cable Car:

You can take the Powell/Hyde line for a very mechanical trip across the city! Each leg of the ride is a new fare - so buy a day pass if you plan to use the cable car for Mechanicrawl.

### Car Parking:

#### Marina Green Park

Parking is free near the Marina Green Park along Marina Blvd. between Buchanan and Scott

#### Fort Mason Center

First ½ hour is free, Daily max \$10.00
